	<p>Now, Tara is going to read the following passages and answer their questions.(4pts)</p> <p>Passage 1</p> <p>Dictionary is a book or an electronic resource that lists the words of a language (typically in alphabetical order) and gives their meaning, or gives the equivalent words in a different language, often also providing information about pronunciation, origin, and usage. Dictionaries are some of the most widely used reference resources. There are both general and specialized dictionaries, such as a medical dictionary and a legal dictionary. Specialized dictionaries provide a more applied definition of words, whereas a general dictionary will list more generally acceptable definitions for the included words.</p> <p>The first English dictionary was written in 1604, but the origin of the dictionary is more commonly belonged to Samuel Johnson in 1755, largely because the previous dictionary was not considered to be especially reliable. Johnson's dictionary was alphabetical and contained textual examples for most of its words. It was expected to take three years but instead took nine years before it was finally published. In 1928 the Oxford English Dictionary (OED) was published, and it has been considered the most reliable dictionary ever since. The first edition of the OED was 70 years in the making. Currently, the OED contains definitions for about 600,000 words. Until recently, the word "set" had the most definitions in the OED, but now its place has been taken by the word "run".</p> <p>With the advent of computers and especially machine translation systems, a new type of dictionary meant especially for computers to use has appeared. This type of dictionary is designed for a computer system to draw information from. Entries are organized in a type of graph format, not in a linear "list" format, and the dictionary is not meant to be printed on paper.
